## Entry Fee/Registration

**Adults 18 and older:** Registrations must be postmarked by Sept 9th. Fee: \$20 (\$30 5K Relay) \*PSU T-Shirt guaranteed to pre-registered 5K participants). After Sept 9th, registration fee is \$25 individual 5K (\$35 5K Relay)

**Youth runners (17 years and younger, 5K or 1 mile course):** Registrations must be postmarked by Sept 9th. Fee: \$15. After Sept 9th, the youth registration fee is \$17. (PSU T-Shirt guaranteed to pre-registered youth race)

**Cubs' Run (4 and younger, 100 yds)** Registrations must be postmarked by Sept 9th. Fee: \$7. After Sept 9th, the fee is \$10. Race day registration is from 8 - 9:45 a.m.

## Course Description

The race starts and finishes at the PSU Lion next to the administration building. The 5K course is a 2 loop course all within the Penn State Campus. The youth race is a 1-mile run all within the Penn State Hazleton campus. Water station available on course. For runners' safety: NO strollers, pets, bikes, or roller blades permitted.

## Age Groups and Awards

5K overall male and female awards for first place. Medals will be awarded to MALE and FEMALE runners in 5 year age groups. 5K Walk awards will go to top 5 Male and Female finishers. The 1-mile kids' race will have medals awarded to MALE and FEMALES in the following age groups: 6 & under (3), 7-8 (3), 9-10 (3), and 11-12 (3). Post-race random drawings and raffles will be held. All Cubs' Run participants will receive a finisher award.

## Free light breakfast, photo with Lion, & Penn State Creamery Ice Cream for participants

*All runners receive a free light breakfast & ice cream during the awards ceremony.* Spectators may also sign up for the breakfast on this registration form. Cost for spectators is \$8 per person.
